White grape varieties to consider (in unoaked form) are Sauvignon Blanc, Riesling, Semillon, Pinot Grigio, Greco, Verdejo and Chenin blanc.

Reds are a little more difficult; as there are only a

few, truly juicy varieties but New World

Merlot, Malbecs and Cabernets fit the

bill as do Old World Garnacha,

Primitivo and of course Beaujolais' s

famous Fleurie.

Inviting aromas of strawberry and redcurrants, followed by a creamy medium-sweet palate showing a nice balance of sweetness and fruit flavours, with a touch of white peppers in the finish.

Grenache / Garnacha, Cinsault, Mourvedre / Monastrell, Tibouren, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah / Shiraz		
Very refined dry rose, with intense aromas of peach, pear, mandarin & melon with floral notes of iris. Buttery & silky on the palate, with citrus fruit, cherry & mango fruit flavours.

Our entry level wine is Spanish made from the Viura grape. Clean floral aromas with notes of tropical fruits makes this an easy drinking wine with a variety of starters.		
2 Forge Mill Chenin Blanc	£4.65	£16.95
Riebeck Valley, Swartland, South Africa		
100% Chenin Blanc		
Very attractive nose with lots of tropical fruits such as pineapple, guava and citrus fruit. Intense palate following the characteristics found on the nose with a refreshing finish.		
3 Valdelainous Verdejo 2013	£4.65	£16.95
Rueda, Spain		
100% Verdejo		
Delicately fragrant on the nose, with typical Verdejo aromas. The palate is crisp yet rounded, with green apple and banana fruit.

100% Chardonnay		
Crisp, ripe wine with refreshingly clean citrus, stone fruit and subtle oak flavours. A wine of class & breeding

Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit character. Vibrant and well-rounded, good persistence of flavour on the finish.

This is a great example of Pinot Grigio. Light, refreshing and with bright aromas of pears, the natural acidity leaves the palate refreshed and the gentle stoney, mineral qualities make it an ideal food partner.

100% Riesling		
Fresh, lively acidity and a medium sweetness on the palate. This delicious wine has flavours of pears and green apples.		
8 Bladen Sauvignon Blanc		£22.50
Wairau Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand		
100% Sauvignon Blanc		
Lively aromas of gooseberry, passionfruit, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalize the palate and provide a refreshing clean finish.

Haut des Ruettes, France		
100% Chenin Blanc		
A medium dry wine with a full and luscious bouquet with hints of apple backed with a taste of sweetness. Enormous fruit flavour, balanced by a perfect level of acidity.		
10 The Little Rascal Ameis		£23.75
Coopers Creek, Gisborne, New Zealand		
100% Arneis		
A remarkably expressive example of this elusive grape variety, showing a mixture of lemons, grapefruit, marmalade, peach and feijoa on the nose. The palate is rich and textural with good length.		
11 Greco 'Giano'		£26.50
Oceno, Campania, Italy		
100% Greco		
This round, expressive Greco infuses superripe stone fruit with the mineral elegance typical of the variety. A dry, full-bodied style, unoaked, but with plenty of savoury richness.		
12 Coopers Creek SV 'Bell Ringer' Albarino	£27.50	
Gisborne, New Zealand		
100% Albarino		
Partially barrel-fermented, it's a great match for seafood & chicken, with classic peach & citrus fruit tones backed by a zesty acid & a touch of saline minerality.		
13 Sancere Domaine Brochard	£29.95	
Loire Valley, France		
100% Sauvignon Blanc		
Classical Sancerre with fine gooseberry fruit and subtle nettle notes, with a clip of acidity. A very fine Sancerre.		
14 Chablis 1er Cru Fourchaume	£29.95	
Domaine des Chenevieres, Burgundy, France		
100% Chardonnay		
Great expression of Chablis from the family vineyards close to the village of Chapelle where the kimmeridgean soils impart true quality. The nose is precise, pure and mineral, with additional notes of citrus. The palate is classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious, with flavours echoing the nose.

Attractive ruby red in colour with a persistent, juicy palate of baited fruits and some tobacco notes.

Stellenbosch, South Africa

A new generation of wines from the Cape, produced by the Rust en Verde team, that combine tradition with the New World ripeness. Aromas of black fruits, underpinned by fruit cakes & spices. Tastes of plum, complimented by notes of chocolate & liquorice.

New South Wales, Australia		
100% Shiraz		
Delicious blackberry fruit with notes of spice and ripe tannins. Cherry aromas with hints of chocolate & cinnamon. On-oaked variety, a cross between Old World and New.

Mendoza, Argentina		
100% Malbec		
A full bodied wine of great refinement and culture. Full aromas of black fruit tinged with hints of vanilla. Tannins are ripe and supple, fruity with blackcurrant notes. Very drinkable with or without meaty dishes.

Wairau Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand.		
100% Pinot Noir		
Hand crafted by Christine & Dave McDonald, established in 1989. Intense aromas of cherry and spice, gently aged in French oak. A beautifully balanced palate, with a well rounded smooth finish. Great with poultry and feathered game.		
21 Sierra Cantabria Rioja Crianza		£22.50
Bodegas, Spain		
100% Tempranillo		
A clean and bright ruby red colour with intense tones. Ripe fruit aromas well balanced complex spice notes and elegant vanilla tones. Sturdy tannins on the palate, with a presence of cocoa and coffee.		
22 Lander-Jenkins Pinot Noir		£23.95
Nappa Valley, California, US		
100% Pinot Noir		
This charming wine offers aromas of red cherry, raspberry, smoky oak and cloves. Sweet ripe cherry and raspberry flavours complement the fine structure and subtle spicy oak. The finish is long and soft, with elegant raspberry fruit.		
23 El Pajaro Rojo, Bierzo 2011		£24.50
Losada Vinos de Finca, Castilla y Leon, Spain		
100% Wida		
From an ancient and locally legendary single vineyard plot. The old vines, meticulously rehabilitated following long abandonment produce an exceptional wine that represents the quintessence of Bierzo.

Stellenbosch, South Africa		
100% Cabernet Sauvignon		
Typical flavour and aroma profiles of dark berries and tobacco with a well-structured and lengthy palate. Aged in old oak, resulting in a touch of sweet spice.		
25 Fleurie Clos de la Roilette		£26.50
Domaine Coudert, Burgundy, France		
100% Gamay		
The best known of the Crus of the Beaujolais and perhaps the most charming. Fresh, floral, fragrant and feminine.		
26 St.Emilion Grand Cru		£26.75
Chateau Pontet Plaisance- France		
Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Franc		
A top class St.Emilion, classically styled yet very approachable at present. Merlot dominates as you would expect yet the backbone of the Cabernet Sauvignon and the Franc give great depth.		
27 Conde de Valdemar Rioja Reserva		£29.50
Bodegas Valdemar, Spain		
85% Tempranillo, 7% Mazuelo, 5% Garnacha, 3% Graciano		
Complex aromas with subtle spicy notes and ripe black fruit touches, leading to a generous, intense palate full of plums, raisins and chocolate. Beautiful balance of fruit and oak, with a long, persistent finish.		
28 Chateaufneuf du Pape Chateau St.Roch		£34.50
Rhone, France		
This well known wine has a rich and full finish. Full bodied with cherries and peach flavours. A great example of a fine wine.
